Arrival: May 17

You will be met at Cairo International Airport by a meet-and-assist agent, who will help you through customs and arrivals, and then escort you to the Kempinski Nile Hotel. Relax and get settled in for the evening, or explore on your own.

Giza and the GEM: May 18

Visit the Pyramids and the Sphinx, enter the Great Pyramid (extra ticket, approximately \$30), and ride a camel to the panoramic viewing area (around \$20). Then visit the Grand Egyptian Museum, the largest archaeological museum in the world (not currently fully open, but hopefully it will be by our trip).

Embarkation Day: May 19

Fly to Aswan in the morning, and after a 3.5 hour private transfer, experience Ramses The Great's Masterpiece, Abu Simbel Temple. Transfer 3.5 hours back to Aswan, and embark on Kemet Danabeya, our luxury yacht for our five night Nlle Cruise. That evening, enjoy the sound and light show at Philae Temple.




Cruising the Nile: May 21

Luxor: May 23

After an optional sunrise hot air balloon ride (\$120 per person), take in the most important ancient sites in Luxor: the Valley of the Kings (including King Tut's Tomb, and the magnificent tomb of Ramses V/VI) and Karnak Temple, the largest ancient Egyptian temple.

Luxor to Cairo: May 24

After seeing Hatshepsut's Temple, we will say goobye to our Dahabeya and crew, and fly back to Cairo. That evening, we will explore Moez Street and the Khan el Khalilii Souk (Market).
